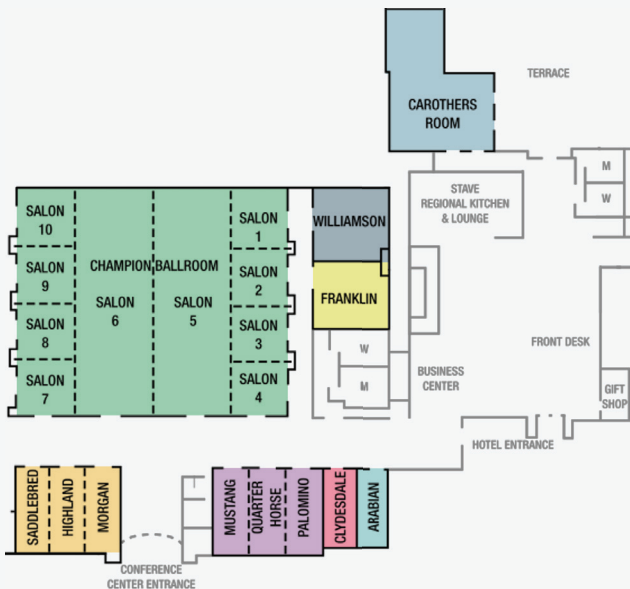

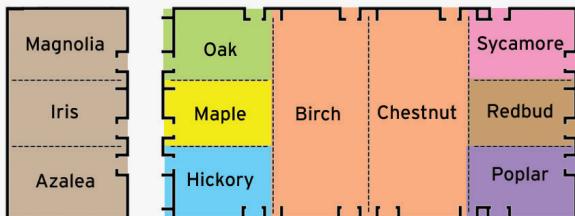

BUTCH WILMORE

Butch Wilmore is a decorated U.S. Navy captain who has flown numerous tactical aircraft operationally while deploying aboard four aircraft carriers during peacetime and combat operations. A graduate of the U.S. Naval Test Pilot School, he went on to serve as a test pilot before NASA selected him to become an astronaut in 2000. During his time at NASA, Wilmore completed three missions to the International Space Station. He conducted five spacewalks, totaling 32 hours outside the orbital laboratory. Most recently, Wilmore launched aboard Boeing's Starliner spacecraft on June 5, 2024, for its first crewed flight test mission, arriving at the space station the following day. After what was suppose to just be a week long stay, he returned to Earth after 286 days.
